



Felt Applique Hex Sign Rug

You will need:

1 yard medium blue felt

1/2 yard gold felt

1/4 yard ivory felt

1/4 yard light blue felt

1/4 yard red felt

9"x12" piece of orange felt

1 yard of backing material (canvas or heavy fabric)

sewing machine

serger (to finish edge of backing material)

yardstick

marker

scissors

matching thread

straight pins



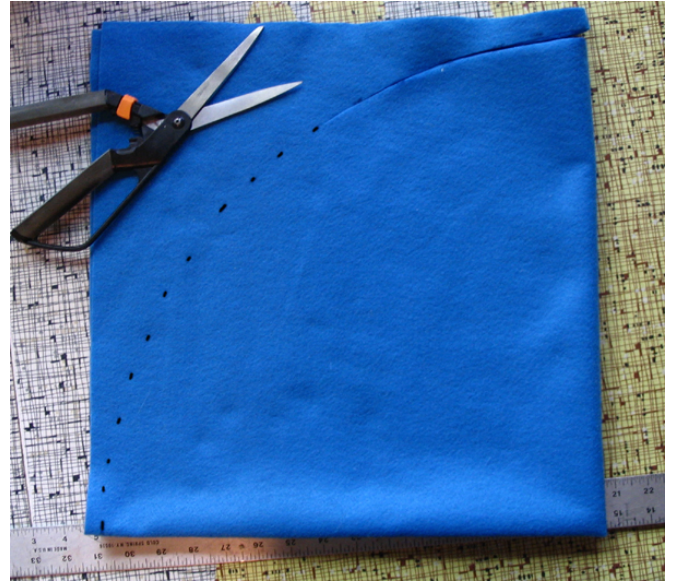
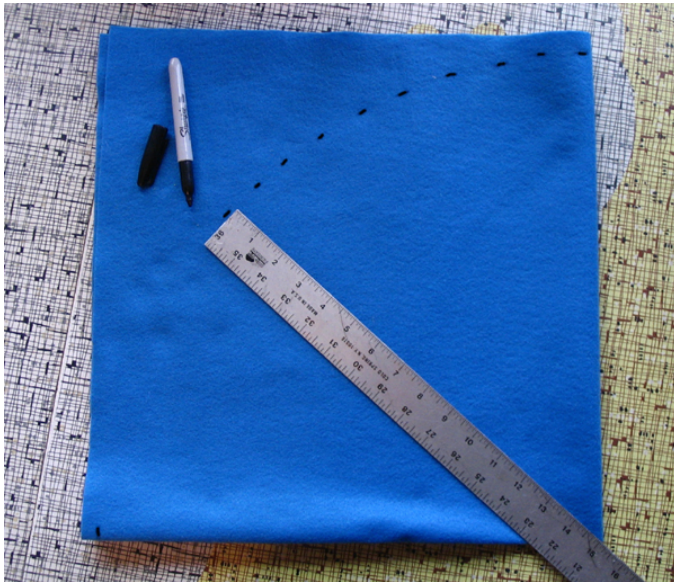
measurements are
based on 36" wide felt

Finished size is 32 inches wide.



Instructions

1. Cut 30" circle out of medium blue felt. To do this, fold the fabric in quarters and measure 15" up from the folded corner. Mark on edge. Pivot ruler on the folded corner and mark every 1-2" until you get to the other edge. Cut along the dotted line and unfold.



2. Place your large circle on top of your backing material and use it as a pattern to cut a 30" circle out of the backing material.

3. Cut applique pieces. (**Pattern pieces are 1/2 of original size, enlarge 200% before cutting**)

4. Place large gold star in center of circle. To center, fold the circle into quarters and crease lightly. Unfold and use crease lines as a guide to center the star. Sew around edge of star.



5. Place orange star in center of gold star and sew around edges, then across the center of star from point to point.



6. Pin rosette petals in place. Check to make sure they are straight using a yardstick. Sew around edges of rosette petals.



7. Center hearts between rosette petals and sew around edges and up the center.

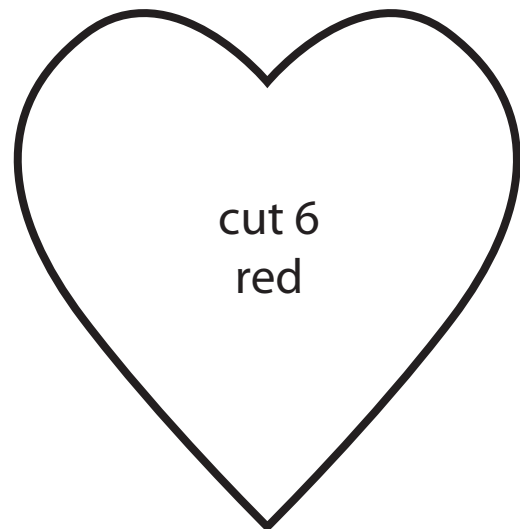
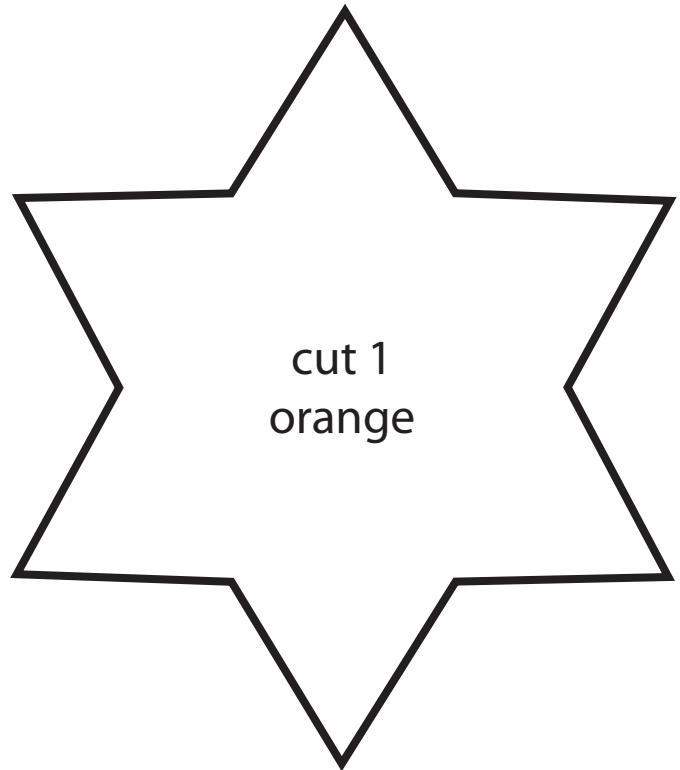
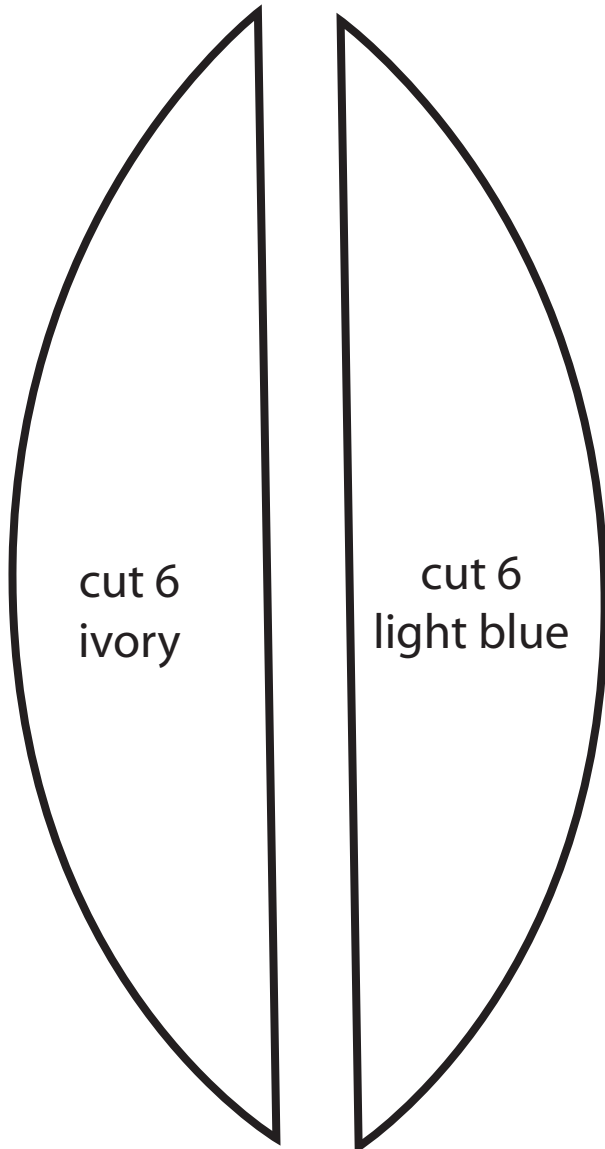
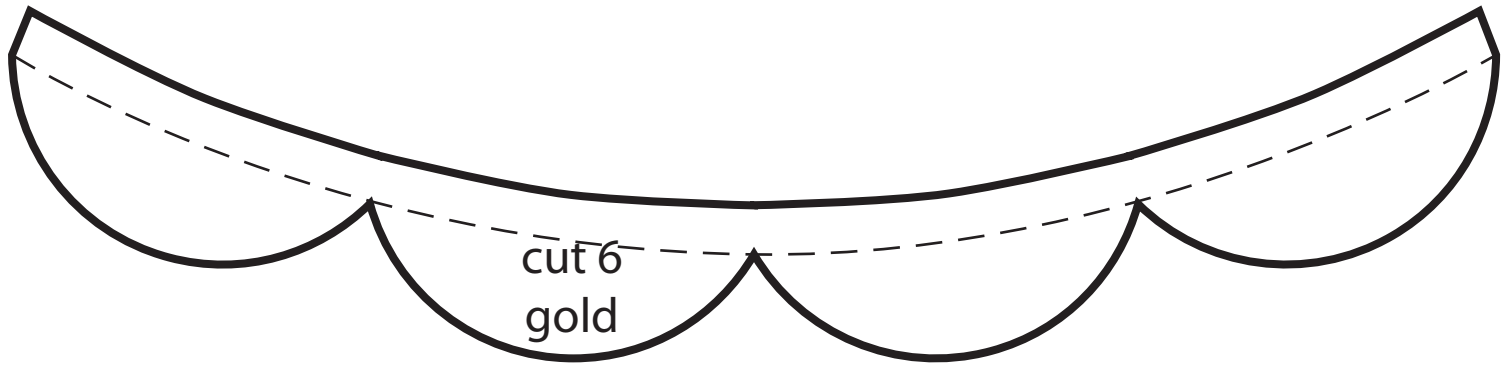


8. Pin scalloped edge underneath the edge of the circle, overlapping so only the scallops are showing (dotted line on pattern piece). Each piece should fit evenly between the ends of the rosette petals. Sew on at the edge of circle.

9. Finish the edge of your backing material with a serger. Pin to back of rug and sew the two layers together around the edge. Iron if needed.
