

MOLDY CUPCAKE

CROCHET PATTERN

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Abbreviations

ch	Chain
sc	Single Crochet
dc	Double Crochet
ea	Each
inc	Increase
lps	Loops
rep	Repeat
FO	Finish Off
sl st	Slip Stitch
CA	Color A (tan)
CB	Color B (green)

Supplies

- Size F crochet hook
- Yarn Needle for finishing
- (1) 12mm Safety Eye
- (1) 15mm Safety Eye
- Stuffing
- Worsted Weight Yarn in tan (CA) and green (CB)
- Green Hairy Yarn (I used Moda Dea Dream) for mold
- Embroidery Floss & Needle for the mouth
- Piece of cardboard (to hold the shape of the bottom)

Parts of this pattern are worked in rounds. Do not join at the end of the rounds. You'll probably want to use a stitch marker to mark your rounds. Gauge is not important but remember to keep your stitches tight.

Bottom

With CA, ch 2. 6 sc in second ch from hook (6)

rnd 1: 2 sc in ea (12)

rnd 2: (1 sc, inc) rep around (18)

rnd 3: (2 sc, inc) rep around (24)

rnd 4: (3 sc, inc) rep around (30)

rnd 5: (4 sc, inc) rep around (36)

sl stl and FO

Sides

With CA, ch 9. 1 sc in ea starting in second ch from hook (8)

row 1: turn, ch 1, 1 sc in ea working in back lps only (8)

row 2: turn, ch 1, 1 sc in ea working in front lps only (8)

rep rows 1 and 2 until you have completed 31 rows total.

Assembly: The side with the lps showing is the right side. Put the last row behind the first and stitch them together. Stitch the side piece to the bottom piece. You may want to cut a piece of cardboard the size of the bottom to put inside to help hold the shape.

Top

With CB, ch 2. 6 sc in second ch from hook (6)

rnd 1: 2 sc in ea (12)

rnd 2: (1 sc, inc) rep around (18)

rnd 3: (2 sc, inc) rep around (24)

rnd 4: (3 sc, inc) rep around (30)

rnd 5: (4 sc, inc) rep around (36)

rnds 6-8 (3 rnds): 1 sc in ea (36)

rnd 9: (5 dc in one st, sc) rep around

sl st and FO

Eye

With CB, ch 2. 6 sc in second ch from hook (6)

rnd 1: 2 sc in ea (12)

rnds 2-4 (3 rnds): 1 sc in ea (12)

Assembly: Place the 12mm safety eye between rnds 1 & 2. Stuff as much as you can and attach to the top. Attach the 15mm safety eye to the top. Embroider the mouth. Using your hairy green yarn and yarn needle, stitch several patches of mold. Using CB, attach the top to the bottom. Make your stitches right behind the row of dcs on the top piece. Stop to stuff before stitching completely shut.
