MATERIALS

- 1 1¼OZ/50G SKEIN (EACH APPROX 85YD/78M) OF BERROCO COTTON TWIST (MERCERIZED COTTON/ RAYON) IN #8314 JONQUIL (A)
- 1 SKEIN IN #8372 LINOLEUM (B)
- ONE PAIR EACH SIZE 7 AND 8 (4.5 AND 5MM) NEEDLES
- TAPESTRY NEEDLE

FLOWER (MAKE 5)

WITH A AND SIZE 7 NEEDLES, CAST ON 10 STS.

ROW 1 (RS) KNIT.

ROW 2 AND ALL EVEN ROWS PURL.

ROW 3 *K1F&B OF ST;

REP FROM * TO END—20 STS.

ROW 5 * K1F&B OF ST;

REP FROM* TO END—40 STS.

ROW 7 *K1F&B OF ST;

REP FROM * TO END—80 STS.

ROW 8 PURL.

BIND OFF.

FLOWER SHAPING

TO SHAPE ROSE, TWIST TO FORM SPIRAL AND SEW IN PLACE AT BACK.

LEAF (MAKE 8)

WITH 2 STRANDS B HELD TOG, MAKE SLIP KNOT. WITH SIZE 8 NEEDLES, CAST ON 5 STS, BIND OFF 5 STS. SL REM ST TO LH NEEDLE. CAST ON 8 STS, BIND OFF 8 STS. FASTEN OFF REM ST. SEW TO FLOWERS (SEE PHOTO).

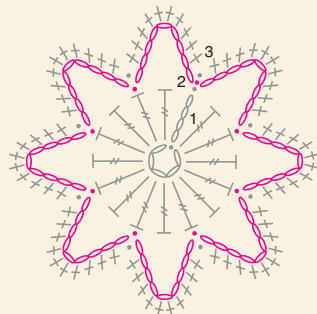
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beaded beauty

materials

1 1½oz/50g ball (approx 99yd/91m)
of Muench String of Pearls
(cotton/viscose/polyester)
in #4004 lime or #4023 turquoise
Size G/6 (4mm) crochet hook
8mm faceted round beads
2mm glass seed beads



Ch 5. Join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1 Ch 4, 15 tr in ring—16 sts.
Join with sl st in top of beg ch.

Rnd 2 *Ch 9, sk next st, sl st in next st;
rep from *, end last rep sl st in base of
beg ch—8 petals.

Rnd 3 *10 sc in next ch-9 sp, sl st in gap
between ch-9 sps; rep from * around.

Fasten off.

Sew beads to center as pictured.

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
