# Pup

## MATERIALS

4.0mm crochet hook  
Worsted weight yarn in lavender and sage green  
Embroidery floss in black and white  
Polyester stuffing material  
Polyester beads for stuffing  
Embroidery needle

## GAUGE

24 stitches x 24 rows = 4"

## FINISHED SIZE

Approx. 4.5"



## Head

*With lavender*

R1—ch2, 6sc in 2nd chain from hook, mm  
R2—2sc in each sc around (12sc), mm  
R3—\*2sc in 1st sc, 1sc in next, repeat from \* around, mm  
R4—\*2sc in 1st sc, 1sc in next 2sc, repeat from \* around, mm  
R5—\*2sc in 1st sc, 1sc in next 3sc, repeat from \* around, mm  
R6—\*2sc in 1st sc, 1sc in next 4sc, repeat from \* around, mm  
R7 thru R13—sc in each stitch around, mm  
R14—\*sc2tog, 1sc in next 4sc, repeat from \* around, mm  
R15—\*sc2tog, 1sc in next 3sc, repeat from \* around, mm  
R16—\*sc2tog, 1sc in next 2sc, repeat from \* around, mm  
R17—\*sc2tog, 1sc in next sc, repeat from \* around, FO  
Stuff firmly.  
Set aside.

## Body

*With lavender*

R1—ch2, 6sc in 2nd chain from hook, mm  
R2—2sc in each sc around (12sc), mm  
R3—\*2sc in 1st sc, 1sc in next, repeat from \* around, mm  
R4 thru 13—sc in each stitch around, FO  
Stuff body with poly beads.  
Attach head to body using whip stitch.

## Arms and Legs (make 4)

*With sage green*

R1—ch2, 6sc in 2nd chain from hook, mm  
R2 thru 6—sc in each stitch around, FO

No need to stuff the arms and legs.

Use tail to stitch up the tiny hole where you finished off.

You should be left with a little appendage that looks like a sausage.

For the legs, stitch to the sides of the body section near the bottom (not to the bottom of the body).

For the arms, stitch into the crux of the neck.

Refer to the chart on page 5 for placement of appendages.

## Ears (make 2)

*With sage green*

R1—ch2, 6sc in 2nd chain from hook, mm  
R2 thru 10—sc in each stitch around, FO

Stitch onto the top of the head. Refer to pictures for placement.

## Nose

With 2 strands of sage green yarn, stitch an upside-down triangle in the center of the face.

*In the photo, the nose is 2 rows high and 4 stitches wide at the widest point.*

## Eyes

With 2 strands of black embroidery floss, stitch on 2 circles parallel to the top of the nose. Add 3 eyelashes and, with 3 strands of white embroidery floss, stitch a twinkle in each eye.
